### Sustainable buildings

80% of the Group's staff work in BREEAM Excellent Certificate buildings across the London and Manchester offices. This includes features such as eco light fittings and movement sensor lighting, recycling programs, green and biodiverse eco walls and roof gardens. The London and Manchester offices have indoor plants which help purify the air.

### Travel

We offer the cycle to work scheme as a benefit for staff who have passed their probation periods.

In order to reduce unnecessary travel between office locations, the Group provides virtual meeting facilities.

Where travel to other offices is required, public transport is recommended as the primary option.

### Company cars

The Group does not provide company cars for its employees.

### Awareness and education

We will improve environmental awareness amongst the Group's staff and promote green housekeeping issues.
